Public transport to St. Stephens Hall

Sunday buses are limited but the following are available:

OUT: Bus 21 from Canterbury Bus Station (Bay A4) at 13:44 to Beaconsfield Road St Stephens (Shaftesbury Road stop) at 13:55

BACK: Bus 5 from St Stephens Hill outside the Beverlie pub at 16:43 to the Bus Station at 16:41 OR Bus 21A from Beaconsfield Road St Stephens (Shaftesbury Road stop) at 17:03 to the Bus Station at 17:12

The stops are within a few minutes walk of the hall.

Canterbury West Station is about 15 minutes walk by footpath (Turn left outside the station and go past the "Goods Shed". Take the footpath under the railway and continue dead straight along the right hand side of the recreation ground. When the next road is reached (St Stephens Hill) the hall is to the right.
